WildEarth Guardians Report Continued From Last Week

2010 was a year to remember. For the campaigns we completed, those we sustained and those that we began. A few actions highlight our creativity and effectiveness. First, our three BioBlitzes during the year, which by their scope and intensity—we filed actions to protect more than 100 imperiled species—forced the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to begin to respond to the biodiversity crisis; second, we invoked a little-known but powerful provision in the Clean Water Act to designate 700 miles of “outstanding waters” in New Mexico; and third, we created a grazing permit retirement account to fund voluntary grazing permit retirement to enhance wolf conservation in the Southwest.

But there was also plenty of actions to fight in 2010, including the Interior Department's continued refusal to protect species like the Sonoran desert tortoise, the wolf-vulture and the greater sage-grouse—three of the more than

250 species that wait and wait for the Endangered Species Act listing logjam to be broken. Though our financial bottom line did not end up where it needs to be, we have a diversified and loyal funding base that we will continue to nurture.

This is what we are up against. It is an endless and tireless liberal organization capitalizing on a loophole that has allowed them to exploit the taxpayers by working through federal agencies using Obama's friends now controlling them. In May, they were awarded \$30 million tax payer dollars by the Department of Interior to settle uncontested lawsuits. A “RACKET” like the Department of Energy's funding bankrupting solar companies in the hundreds of millions of taxpayer dollars--another clean energy hoax.

The reason we need to move fast with the OPERATION BATTLE CRY CAMPAIGN is because even though the Sand Dune Lizard was deemed by the federal agencies NOT endangered, the New Mexico Fish and Wild Life Service continues to act as though this determination had not happened. The following is proof the scam is coming down from the Department of Interior and covered up by the refusal of the US Congress to defund the fraud and extortion that will actually allow our oil and gas fields in New Mexico and the Permian Basin to be confiscated due to the Director of Fish and Wild Life, Dan Ashe's decision to list the sand dune lizard on December 14th as actually being “endangered.” THE FACTS DON'T MATTER TO HIM, THE WILDEARTH GUARDIANS, OR THE WHITE HOUSE. This is just another Obama initiative that will become law if the Lord does not intervene.

Look at the record of the WildEarth Guardians and see why I need you and your help right now to pull down the strongholds of these racketeers.

Our efforts were aimed at compelling the federal government to implement the U.S. Endangered Species Act (ESA) as a contribution to the world's efforts to preserve biodiversity.

As a result of our energetic campaign, a number of species have a renewed chance at survival.

- We secured court victories for the Gunnison's and Utah prairie dogs that require the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to review how to best protect these animals.
- Court settlements we obtained resulted in recovery plans for the fin and sperm whales.
- **The sand dune lizard, for which we have steadily pressed for federal listing, was proposed for protection at long last.**
- Advocated for strong protection of Utah's national forests from logging and oil and gas development.
- **Fought forest biomass energy development in New Mexico.**

- Advocated for strong environmental analysis and public participation in the Obama Administration's national forests planning rule.
- Removed miles of barbed wire fencing within the Valles Caldera National Preserve in northern New Mexico to reestablish wildlife migration corridors.

May 7 Took on San Juan power plant for its failure to rein in carbon dioxide emissions

May 17 Called on Dept. of Interior to hold BLM to accountable oil and gas leasing

June 10 Sued federal government seeking to increase grazing fees on public lands

June 11 Requested an end to trapping and snaring of Mexican wolves in southern NM

- Applied for and awarded over \$1.1 million dollars in federal, state, and private funding for continued restoration projects in 2011 and 2012.

June 29 Sued federal government for failure to list two sage-grouse species under the ESA

July 15 Filed suit to list the New Mexico jumping mouse under the ESA

July 22 Called out former BLM Field Manager now working for oil and gas industry

WildEarth Guardians has always used litigation as a means to hold the federal government as well as private industry accountable to our nation's environmental laws. However, in the past, we had to beg and plead with collaborating attorneys to take on our cases. Sometimes those attorneys simply couldn't take on our lawsuits and a species suffered, a wild place was scarred or a precious stream ran dry. Fortunately, those days are over. Three years ago, WildEarth Guardians began assembling our own in-house legal team. Jay Tutchton became our first on staff attorney and currently spearheads our fearless team as our General Counsel. Coming from University of Denver's law school, Jay is one of the preeminent biodiversity advocates in the country.

Look at the actual law suit filed by the WildEarth Guardians demanding the Sand Dune Lizard be listed by December 14th in New Mexico and the Permian Basin. With this information we can reverse their victory and demand Congressional investigations for funds paid to them based on bogus law suits.

Our lawyers are willing to take risks to pioneer new legal ground to advance legal safeguards. They further conservation advocacy by obtaining court decisions that have real world, on the ground effects.

The plaintiffs our legal team represents – wildlife, wild places and wild rivers – won a lot in 2010. Not only did these winnings result in the conservation successes you see in our program recaps, they also resulted in the financial capital to

continue our advocacy work. As you may have noticed, ten percent of our 2010 income came from our legal victories. While our litigation strategies are never driven by financial gain, the settlements we are awarded when we make a winning case for the environment help our organization to survive and thrive.

Following is a copy of the original letter sent to the Department of Interior by WildEarth Guardians that started the whole process of confiscating Texas and New Mexico oil lands. It's taken them four years, but they are almost at their goal.

Dear Secretary Kempthorne and Director Hall,

Pursuant to the Endangered Species Act ("ESA") and the Administrative Procedure Act ("APA"), WildEarth Guardians hereby petitions you to list the sand dune lizard (*Sceloporus arenicolus*) on an emergency basis under the ESA. 16 U.S.C. §1533(b)(3)(C)(iii) and § (b)(7) (emergency listing authority of the ESA) and; 5 U.S.C. § 553(e) (right to petition under the APA). Under the ESA, the Secretary "shall implement a system to monitor effectively the status of all species," such as the sand dune lizard, which the Secretary has determined are warranted, but precluded from listing, 16 U.S.C. § 1533(b)(3)(C)(iii), and "shall make prompt use of the authority under [16 U.S.C. §1533(b)(7) (emergency listing authority)] to prevent a significant risk to the well being of any such species." 16 U.S.C. § 1533(b)(3)(C)(iii). The APA allows any citizen to petition an agency for the issuance of a rule or regulation within the agency's power.

In addition, we hereby provide you with formal 60-day notice of our intent to file suit under the citizen suit provision

of the ESA, 16 U.S.C. § 1540, contending that your finding in the December 6, 2007 Candidate Notice of Review, 72 Fed. Reg. 69034- 69106, that the sand dune lizard does not warrant emergency listing under the ESA was arbitrary and capricious in violation of the ESA and APA. 16 U.S.C. § 1533(b)(3)(C)(iii) and § (b)(7); 5 U.S.C. § 706(2)(A). If you do not reverse this arbitrary finding or indicate firm plans to list the sand dune lizard immediately, WildEarth Guardians intends to file suit, no sooner than 60-days from today's date, to address your violations of the law. While Director Hall stated to Congress on February 28, 2008 that the Service would issue a proposed listing determination for the sand dune lizard in 2008 and a final listing determination in 2009, we have no basis for believing that the sand dune lizard will actually be listed under the ESA within this timeframe given the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's (Service's) past behavior. The Service is unlikely to meet self-imposed deadlines for action and offers only the possibility of protection in 2009 rather than certainty that the lizard will actually be listed. Our petition and potential lawsuit seek to force certain protection in 2008.

Moreover, based on information already in the Service's files it is clear that Moreover, based on information already in the Service's files it is clear that there will be "significant risk to the well being" of the sand dune lizard if it is not immediately listed under the ESA. This significant risk stems from ongoing impacts to lizards and their habitat due to poorly regulated oil and gas exploitation, shinnery oak removal, off-road vehicle use, toxic fumes, and other factors that are compounded by the extremely narrow range of this species. In short, as leading scientific researchers and agency biologists have recognized (e.g., Snell et al. 1997), every month that goes by in which the lizard does not enjoy the protections of the ESA pushes this rare reptile closer to extinction.
